Conporec delivers New York facility

Conporec Inc., a company specializing in domestic waste management through its own composting technology, has delivered its first sorting-composting facility outside Quebec. The \$25-million facility in Walton, N.Y., has an annual processing capacity of 41,500 tonnes. Conporec said the equipment will enable the region to reclaim more than 80 per cent of the region's domestic waste, material that normally goes to landfills where it generates gas released into the atmosphere. Conporec has operated a composter in Sorel for 10 years, while its third is soon to be completed in suburban Paris.
